Business Basics: Our Business World <i>grades 5-7</i>	1.5 hr	1-2 hr	4 one-hour sessions	Flexible during school hours	Introduces key business concepts and gives students hands-on experience in different areas of small business.
Business Basics: A Business of Our Own <i>grades 6-8</i>	1.5 hr	1-2 hr	5 one-hour sessions	Flexible during school hours	Provides students with the opportunity to apply their knowledge and skills by managing their very own retail business.
Economics for Success <i>grades 9 & 10</i>	1.5 hr	1-2 hr	½ day session or split into 2-4 sessions	Scheduled dates; 8am – 2pm (Flexible)	Encourages students to reflect on the advantages of an education to acquire the knowledge, attitudes and skills needed for long-term career success.
Investment Strategies Program <i>grades 9 & 10</i>	2 hr	2 hr	5 one-hour sessions	Flexible during school hours	An interactive program that gives high school students hands-on experience in an on-line stock market simulation. Students learn how to make wise and socially responsible investment decisions.
Company Program – A Student Venture in-school <i>grades 11 & 12</i>	1.5 hr	3 hr	6 one or two hour sessions	Flexible depending on school. Must be completed in 10-16 week period.	Fosters the entrepreneurial spirit of students and helps them to develop their understanding of the role of business in our society by creating an enterprise of their own.
Company Program – A Student Venture after-school <i>grades 11 & 12</i>	2 hr	3-4 hr	10-12 one or two hour sessions	Scheduled dates after school. Must be completed in 16 week period.	See the In School program above. 3-4 person volunteer team is responsible for program delivery. There is no in-class teacher involvement.
JA Titan Business Game <i>grades 11 & 12</i>	1-2 hr	2-4 hr	6-7 one or two hour sessions	Flexible depending on school. Must be completed in 5-8 weeks.	An interactive web-based business simulation where high school students compete as companies in a fictitious market. Schools that participate in Titan are eligible to submit teams to our BC Business Challenge held annually in the Lower Mainland.
