



**Junior Achievement of British Columbia**  
**2009-2010 Award for Excellence and Leadership**

Leadership skills may be acquired and demonstrated in many different ways. This award recognizes achievement in the development of effective personal and business management skills which could contribute to an individual's future career.

## Eligibility

The eligible applicants for this award:

- should be willing and able to fully participate in the 2010 **Next Generation Leaders Forum** scheduled for August 7-13, 2010. This year's international JA student conference, formerly known as CANJAC, will be held at Queens University in Kingston, Ontario. It is one of the largest gatherings of JA students around the world, and we are proud to say it is coordinated annually by Junior Achievement of Canada.

- must be secondary students who have participated in a senior (grade 10/11/12) JA program during the 2009 - 2010 school year
- may be participants in Company Program – A Student Venture, or TITAN Business Game
- must be recommended by a business education teacher/ consultant/advisor
- should display competent written and oral communication skills and be interested in current affairs and business-related topics
- are not previous recipients of this scholarship

\*Note: A program may present more than one applicant for this award, and it is not necessary for an applicant to hold an executive position in the JA program in order to be considered for this award.

## Requirements

If short-listed for this scholarship, applicants may be required to attend a brief interview in person or by telephone

## Recognition

The winner will be entitled to a scholarship (covering tuition, travel, accommodation and meals) to attend **Next Generation Leaders Forum** Junior Achievement of Canada's international student conference to be held in August 2010. There is no cash substitute for this award.

As there is no cash substitute for this award, it is expected that the winner will make every effort to attend. In the event the winner is unable to attend, JABC will select an alternate award candidate to accept the scholarship.

## Application Due Date: Tuesday, May 25, 2010

- The winner will be notified by June 3, 2010.
- The winner will be recognized at JABC's Provincial awards presentation June 10, 2010, and at Regional events as appropriate.
